- See items from 100 years ago, including badges, photographs, certificates, uniform and more.
- Learn new skills and connect with new people. There are lots of skills to develop working in a team, discovering and checking information, communication, building confidence. If you are interested in History, Media, Psychology, Art, Textiles, then these are just some of the subjects that the project will relate to.
- Help put ARC on the map with its socials help us create material for our platforms such as Facebook, Tik Tok and Instagram.
