

## The Jubilee House Challenge

The Jubilee House Challenge can be completed during one stay or multiple stays the only condition is that clauses can only be counted when you are staying residentially, it is unfortunately not for day visitors.

There are four sections to the challenge;

- High & Low

Rainbows complete 1 clause per section

Brownies complete 2 clauses per section

Guides complete 3 clauses per section

Senior Section & Leaders complete 4 clauses per section

## Stay Over

Rainbows & Brownies	Guides & Senior Section

Use 2 types of brushes during your stay at Jubilee House	Use 3 types of brushes during your stay at Jubilee House
Pack your own bag to go home from Jubilee House	Make a water proof bedding roll whilst at Jubilee House and test it
Design and make a place mat to use at Jubilee House	Bivouac at Jubilee House
Design a pair of pyjamas or a onesie to be worn at Jubilee House	Spend at least a night inside & a night outside at Jubilee House (this doesn't need to be as part of the same camp or holiday)
Keep a diary of your stay at Jubilee House	Write a 'Trip Advisor' review about your stay at Jubilee House

See if you can spot the North star and the Plough high in the sky whilst you are staying at Jubilee House	Make something using pioneering techniques

Tell your friends about your 'high' or favourite bit of being at Jubilee House	Identify at least 3 star constellations whilst staying at Jubilee House
